Dr. Mamun joined our faculty on January 1, 2006. He is teaching FIN 801 (Corporate Finance).

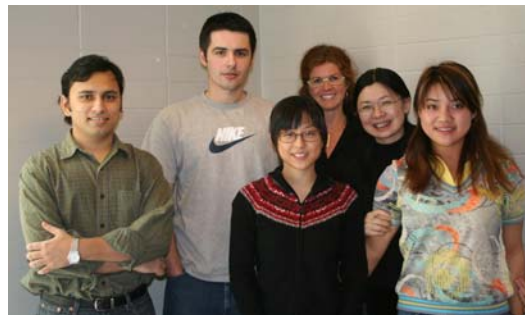


Zhen (Jenny) Li

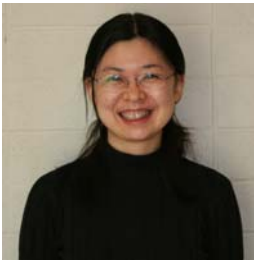
