**Abstract**: This research presentation addresses the research question: "Why do you Conduct Research in a Business School?" I address this compelling research question by compiling extensive prior literature into an intuitive model of a modern business school. The predictions of the model has implications for our Canadian business schools and the preparedness of the Canadian economy to meet challenges going forward.
