

TRANSFER CREDIT AGREEMENT



Aboriginal Financial Management Diploma

About the Agreement

The Aboriginal Financial Officers Association (AFOA) of Canada and the Edwards School of Business at the University of Saskatchewan (USask) have established a transfer agreement for academic programming in support of the growing Aboriginal population in Canada.

Students who graduate with an Aboriginal Financial Management (AFM) Diploma with a minimum overall program grade point average of 65% will be conditionally admitted to the B.Comm. program. Students must take the Mathematics Placement Test prior to September in the year of their admission and earn a grade of 70% or higher in order for their conditional admission to be changed to full admission. If the student does not attain a minimum grade of 70%, they must successfully complete MATH 102.3: University Pre-Calculus within their first year of study to be fully admitted to the B.Comm. program.

Students admitted under this transfer agreement will receive credit for 42 credits (14 classes), allowing them to complete

the program in approximately 2.5 years on the basis of full-time study. Any successfully completed courses from other post-secondary institutions will also be assessed for credit at the time of admission. Edwards will allow students to transfer up to a total of 60 credit units (out of 120) of transferable courses from another college or institution.

All applicants to Edwards will follow the USask transfer student admissions process. The September admission deadline is February 15 and the January admission deadline is December 1. All applicants must ensure that original transcripts are sent directly from AFOA to the USask Transfer Credit Office.
